Located in Caloundra, The Observatory complex consists of 39 high-end apartments across six storeys.

The building geometry is well-defined with an expressed structure and large skillion roofs.

The distinctive Queen Street façade incorporates the use of piloti style columns at the ground level entry, and then merges with the main elliptical expressed columns.

The entire façade is heavily articulated with balconies, glazed handrails, solid balustrades, louvre screens with concealed air conditioning units, and extensive glazing panels.

The roof terrace also consists of several major stand out features such as two dominant skillion roofs struttred over two storeys.
