

CHARLOTTE'S BAR & BISTRO

The resultant design for this bistro produced a functional layout of dining areas to one side, and service areas to the rear and opposite site of the tenancy.

The initial brief for Charlotte's Bar & Bistro was to cater for the breakfast needs of hotel guests from the above building and to service the local office workers during the lunch period with a bar that would capture the social 'after work' drinking patronage.

The bar consists of bright colours and features to attract pedestrian attention, with a 'theatre style' kitchen allowing patrons to view the cooking activities.

The dining area showcases several feature décor items varying from built-in wine cabinets, artwork panels, lighting fans, and feature cabinetry.

The warm atmosphere is emphasised through interior colour selections which compensate for the predominantly cold and shady orientation of the restaurant.
